- All vendors must have a seller's permit.
  - -<sup>1</sup> Fremont resident and business vendors: Fremont Business Tax permit is required. Obtain thru City of Fremont.
  - <sup>2</sup> Non-Fremont resident or business vendors: Also submit a Fremont Special Event Business Tax form (\$5/day) with your MSJ Chamber application to us, See separate form.
  - Live plant vendors shall must have documentation from the Dept of Agriculture of the company merchandise is purchased from.
- Food vendors are required to follow current Alameda County Dept. of Env. Health Rules <u>and</u> obtain a Temporary Food Facility Permit (TFF). <u>https://deh.acgov.org/operations/tff.page?</u>
- Food Truck vendors are required to follow current Alameda County Dept. of Env. Health Rules and/<u>or</u> obtain a Mobile Food Facility permit (MFF). <u>https://deh.acgov.org/operations/mff.page</u>?



- Electricity is NOT available. Small, quiet generators are acceptable (Honda)
